



Rossville Christian Academy FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- **Q: How many students** attend RCA?
A: As of the 2017-18 school year, we have 300 students enrolled 4-K-12. (Lower School: 140) (Middle/High School: 160)
- **Q:** What is the typical **number of students in a class**?
A: Average of 15
- **Q:** What is the **student:teacher ratio**?
A: 12:1
- **Q:** What is the **dress code**?
A: Uniform dress code guidelines are detailed in the Student Handbook (available on our website under the “Campus Life” tab).
General: Bottoms: khaki/navy shorts/pants/skirts/skorts (jeans on Fridays)
Tops: solid red/white/navy polo style or collared button down
Shoes: closed-toed shoes
- **Q:** What **sports** are offered?
A: Middle/High School: football, baseball, basketball, trapshooting, volleyball, softball, track, golf, cheerleading; Lower School: various sports are offered based on interest/numbers
- **Q:** Outside of athletics, what other **extra-curricular activities** are offered?
A: Clubs (STEM, 4-H, Fellowship of Christian Athletes, Best Buddies, Drama); Choir; Student Government Association; International Travel Program, Honor Societies (Beta, Spanish, and Math); Service Projects
- **Q:** What **curriculum** do you use?
A: Our curriculum is designed to be Biblically-based and college preparatory. Please refer to our Program of Studies (in the Prospective Family packet and on our website under the “Academics” tab) for course descriptions and graduation requirements.
- **Q:** Is RCA a “**one-to-one**” device school? (i.e., Does every student have a laptop or iPad?)
A: At RCA, we believe the teacher is the most important instrument in delivering quality instruction. While technology is a vital part of the educational experience at RCA, we firmly believe it does not supersede the value of an excellent teacher. RCA is not “one-to-one;” however, our students use technology extensively in their classes; they have access to **Mimeo Smart Boards, iPads, laptops, and media centers (computer labs).**

- **Q:** Do you offer **ACT prep**?

A: Yes, ACT prep is incorporated into our courses, and students have the opportunity to attend workshops. Since 2014, we have had twenty-five graduates score a **25 or above** (composite) on the ACT.
- **Q:** What is your **college acceptance rate**?

A: 100% of our students who apply to college are accepted. Since 2015, our graduates have been accepted to **over 60** colleges and universities. Since 2013, our graduates have been awarded over **5.3 million dollars** in scholarships.
- **Q:** Do you offer **scholarships or financial aid** for tuition?

A: We partner with FACTS, a third party organization, through which families may apply for financial aid. FACTS will determine, based on income, if a family is eligible for any tuition assistance. After the FACTS report is complete, RCA's Board of Directors Visit the following website to apply:

A: We offer many honors and AP level classes in various subjects including Math, English, History, and Science. We also offer opportunities for dual-enrollment.
